Celebrations at BHS:

- **Students and teachers have been able to remain in a full-time in person learning environment for three full quarters!** Administrators, teachers, and support staff are thankful to the Blair community for their continued support and cooperation with COVID protocols.
- **Approximately 80% of the total student population are passing ALL classes!** BHS staff has engaged in an analytical review of the number of students failing classes and reflecting on core instructional practices that will positively impact this number.
