



BHS Quarter One Review - 2020/2021

As the 20/21 school year continues to progress, I wanted to take this opportunity to share successes from the first quarter at BHS:

- **Students and teachers have been able to remain in a full-time in person learning environment for ten full weeks!** Here are the number of students accessing the other two learning options at Blair High School:
 - 46 virtual learners = 6.9% of the total population
 - 33 remote learners = 4.95% of the total population
- **Approximately 80% of the total student population are passing ALL classes!** BHS staff has engaged in an analytical review of the number of students failing classes and reflecting on core instructional practices that will positively impact this number.
- **ACT and preACT tests were taken by Juniors and Seniors in September.** Results will be shared when they become available.
- **All extracurricular activities have been able to safely experience the Fall season and winter season prep is beginning!**
- **The following safety precautions are still in place to ensure that school is able to stay in session and to keep BHS students and staff safe:**
 - Masks are required at all times except while eating at lunch.
 - Hand sanitizer is available and students are encouraged to use it frequently. In addition, frequent desk cleaning occurs in the classrooms and at lunch.
 - When possible, physical distancing is promoted.
 - Temperature checks occur as students enter the building.
