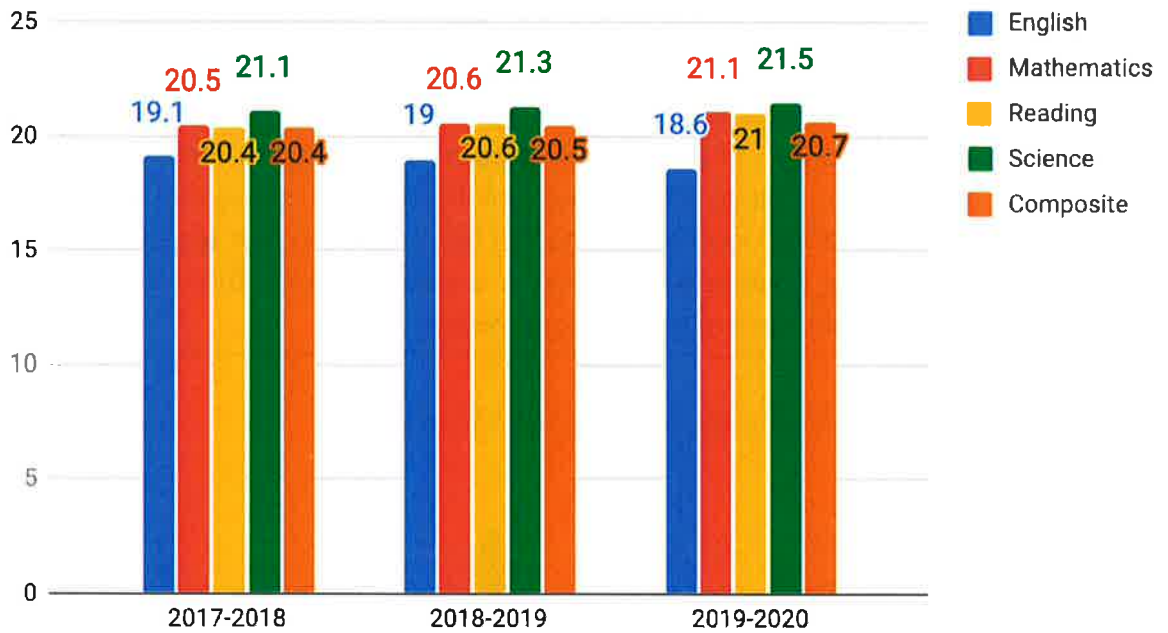
Welcome 2021!

- **The ACT test was taken by this years' Seniors in September.**

All Juniors in the state of Nebraska have been required to take the ACT beginning in 2017-18. The 5th bar in the chart below for each year is the composite score. You will notice the composite score for BCS is consistent over the last three years.

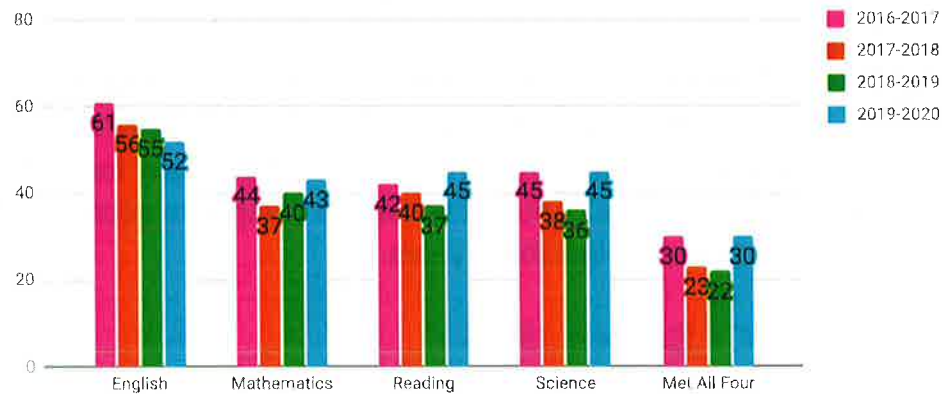
Average ACT Scores - BCS



- **The ACT test was taken by this years' Seniors in September.**

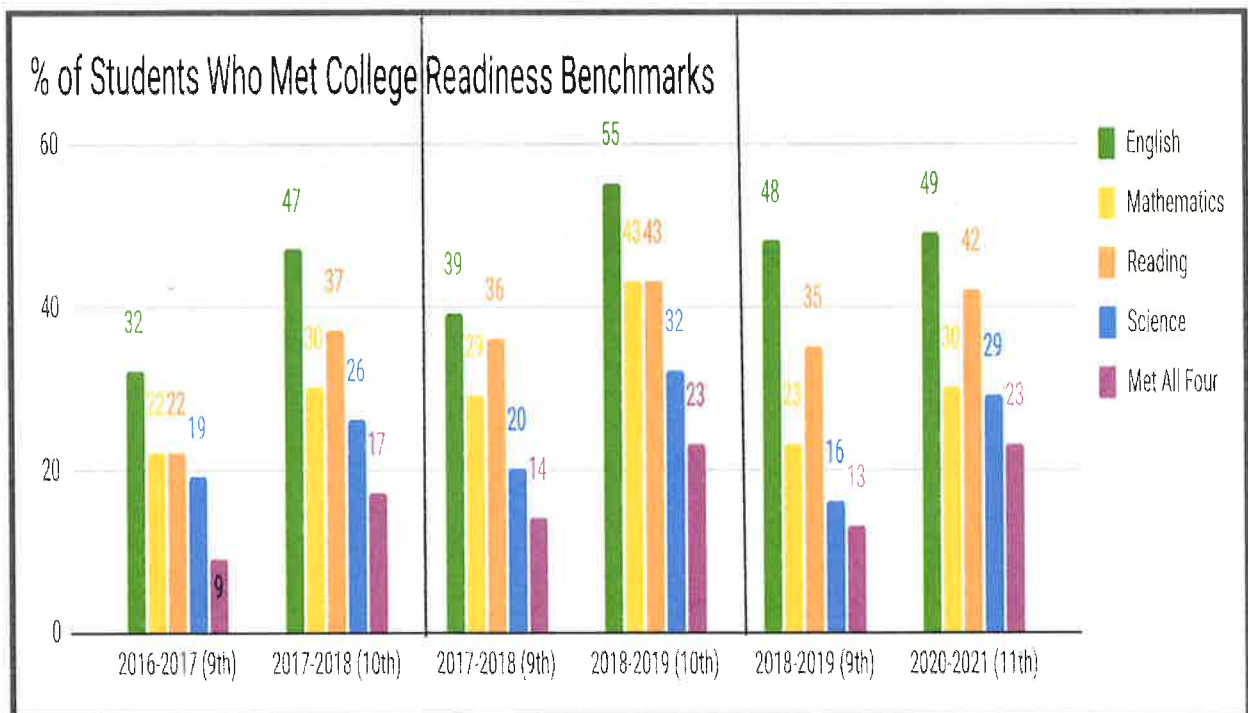
The College Readiness benchmark score is the minimum score needed on an ACT subject-area test to indicate a 50% chance of obtaining a B or higher in the corresponding credit-bearing college courses, which include English Composition, Algebra, Social Science, Biology, STEM, and ELA.

- **The preACT test was taken by this years' Juniors in September.**

Typically, the preACT is taken by students as Freshmen and again as Sophomores. This ultimately prepares students for the ACT. Due to the pandemic, this year's Juniors took the preACT in the Fall instead of last Spring. If you look at just the 5th bar in each 2 year testing period, you will notice positive growth from the same students that took the preACT their freshmen and sophomore years..
